BE AMBITIOUS:

If you're looking to gain a plumbing apprenticeship, enrol in the TAFE NSW pre-apprenticeship course. Commencing in July 2020, this 18 week program, will help you to:

- learn basic foundations and develop skills and knowledge used in the construction industry
- learn about safe work practices and their context within the construction industry
- become job ready

COSTS:

A PPE (Personal protective equipment) and tools charge of \$500 will apply. This excludes boots.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible for this pre-apprenticeship course you must:

- Be aged between 16 and 25
- Be released from school
- Have a Year 10 Record of Student Achievement (ROSA)/USI result, or be over 17 years old
- Hold a white card (general construction induction card)
- Live or work in NSW
- Be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident, a humanitarian visa holder, or a NZ citizen

Please bring your portfolio and resume (including your Year 10 School Certificate, or completion of Year 10 (ROSA)/USI result to the interview. And if you have previously studied plumbing, please also provide any relevant documents.
