

Year 10 - Visual Arts 2023

Students learn about the history of painting in Semester 1. This course gives students the opportunity to experiment with painting techniques and colour theory to develop skills and conventions of painting in a range of painting mediums such as acrylic, watercolour and oils. Students explore the postmodern concept of appropriation in theory and in their artmaking.
